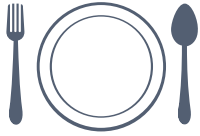


Tipping Your Wedding Vendors



Caterer

If not already added into the bill, tip 15-20% of the total bill. Another option is to tip \$20-50/server and \$50-100 per chef.

Wedding Planner/Coordinator

Typically, planners don't expect a tip, but you can tip them 10-20% if they went above and beyond for you.

Florist/Decorator

Florists also don't expect a tip, but if they gave outstanding product and customer service, consider tipping 10-15%.

Photographer/Videographer

If photographers own their own studio, it is not necessary to tip them, but if they work under a large studio it is nice to tip them \$50-100.

DJ/Musician

A 10-15% tip for your band or DJ is a typical gesture. Another option is to offer \$20-50 per band member.

Transportation Services

Tipping for transportation is optional, but often people tip 15% if not already included in the bill.
